

EASTBURY COMMUNITY SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR GOVERNORS

This code of conduct was originally adopted by the Governing Body meeting on 14 November 2012 alongside the National Governors Association Code of Practice for School Governors and the recommendations of the Nolan Committee, reproduced below.

Date of review : 6 December 2017

1. All mobile phones to be set to silent during meetings, any emergency calls or texts to be made outside of the meeting room to minimise disruption
2. Governors/staff attending meetings must indicate to the Chair if they want to speak
3. Governors must be punctual for all meetings
4. Apologies must be tendered for non-attendance at all meetings
5. All Governors to bring agenda and papers to meetings, these are sent out in advance, usually by email. If any Governor requires a hard copy, let Karen Dunnell (0208 507 4518) know
6. All Governors to participate in appropriate training offered by the LEA
7. All Governors to wear name badges and appropriate dress code when on school premises
8. Governors should be active participants at meetings
9. There must be no personal gain for any Governor
10. The code of practice should be reviewed annually and signed by Governors at the first meeting of the academic year.

Undertaking:

As a member of the Governing Body I will always have the well-being and academic progress of the children and the reputation of the school at heart; I will do all I can to be an ambassador for the school, publicly supporting its aims, values and ethos; I will never say or do anything publicly that would embarrass the school, the Governing Body, the Executive Headteacher or staff.
