Yr12/ Yr13 Unit1 & unit 3	<p>The students learn and develop their practical skills within the 3-Dimensional area. In yr12 & yr13 the students produce a Portfolio of work set and marked by the centre and moderated by AQA. They gather primary and secondary research showing evidence of different techniques and medias. The student uses their ideas to create their designs. In the winter term the students create a 3D Design product using their design work and the skills they have developed and learnt.</p> <p>During Unit 3 in yr13 the students have a written element relating to their portfolio 1000-3000 words.</p>
Yr12 Unit 2	<p>The students learn and develop skills in practical. In yr12 the students produce a Portfolio of work set and marked by the centre and moderated by AQA. They gather primary and secondary research, showing evidence of different techniques and medias. The student uses their ideas to create their designs. In the spring term the students create a 3D Design product using their design work and the skills they have learnt. The students have a 5 hours controlled assessment in April.</p>
Yr13 unit 4	<p>The students learn and develop their practical skills developed from their AS year. In yr13 the students produce a Portfolio of work set and marked by the centre and moderated by AQA. They gather primary and secondary research, showing evidence of different techniques and medias. The students use their ideas to create and develop their designs. In the spring term the students create a 3D Design product using their design work and the skills they have learnt. The students have a 15 hours controlled assessment to produce a final piece in April.</p>
Homework	Work independent on their portfolio and visiting exhibitions and museums to help with their research.
Additional information	In yr12 and yr13 students work will be displayed in exhibition within the school. Opportunities for trips.
