



Eastbury Community School Nursery Information



Times

The A.M session begins at 8:30am. At the end of the session the door will open at 11:20am for you to collect your child. The Nursery closes at 11:30am so please be prompt when collecting your child at the end of each day. The P.M session begins at 12:30pm. At the end of the session the door will open at 3:20pm for you to collect your child. The Nursery closes at 3:30pm so please be prompt when collecting your child at the end of each day.

Attendance

If your child is sick or unable to attend Nursery please phone the office and leave a message with Mrs Edwards or Mrs Harris (020 8507 4612) or on the school's answer machine.

Messages

If you have a message about your child or for a member of staff, please feel free to speak to us at the beginning of the session.

Collection

Please inform staff and the office of any changes to who will be collecting your child and ensure that all adults who could possibly be collecting your child are listed on the pupil information form.

Coat/Uniform/Jewellery

The children will be encouraged to wear school uniform which will consist of a red school sweatshirt, white polo shirt and black jogging bottoms with black sensible shoes with Velcro. The girls can wear red check dresses in warmer weather and boys can wear shorts.

Please ensure you purchase Eastbury Community School Primary School uniform. All clothing must be labelled and no jewellery to be worn.

Spare Clothes

Your child must have a carry bag of labelled spare clothes in school. If your child is in nappies please can you remember to put a few in the bag with some wet wipes - No backpacks/rucksacks

Bookbag

Please name your child's book bag, check them and empty weekly – No backpacks/rucksacks.

Nursery Notice Board

Please check our classroom notice board on our window in the Early Years playground daily.

Website

Please check the school website for whole school updates regarding school term holidays, key events and other information.

Library Book

In the spring term your child will visit the school library and be given a book to take home for you to read together. If the book is damaged or lost there will be a £5 charge.

Medication

All medication should be clearly labelled with your child's name and given to the class teacher.

Water Bottles

Please can you bring in a water bottle with your child's name on. This will be sent home at the end of each session and will be needed every day.

Mobile Phones
